

**Minutes of Meeting of SCL Pension Adalat-2018 held on 29.8.2018**

At the outset, Chairman welcomed the Members and Invitees to the Pension Adalat-2018.

2. Adalat was informed by the Member Secretary that as on date there are 82 Pensioners including 15 Family Pensioners of SCL and most of them are residing in and around tri-city except few who are residing in the adjoining rural areas. During the year and notice period for conduct of Adalat, no grievances have been received from any of the pensioners. This may be due to the fact that most of the raised issues during the year have been resolved by the dealing officials over phone and personal interaction.

3. Subsequently following agenda points were taken up for discussions:

- (a) Suggestions have been received from few Pensioners that Identity Card should be printed with National Emblem.

It was informed to the Adalat that as per DPPW(GOI) OM No.41/21/2000-P&PW (D) dated 25.7.2013, it has been clarified that the Pensioner Identity Card to retired Govt. servants only establishes the identity of the person/pensioner and it does not confer any right on the pensioner to enter into a security zone. Therefore, it would not be necessary to have the National Emblem on their identity cards. This was agreed to by the Adalat.

- (b) Some of the Pensioners have been requesting for details of monthly pension credited to their accounts including deductions.

SBI officials brought out that they are providing all the details of pension including income tax deductions and their office is catering to more than 7 lakhs pensioners of UT, Punjab, Haryana, HP. Keeping in view that SCL is likely to be upgraded as ISRO Centre in the near future, the matter will be taken care by SBI, once the pension cases are transferred to Central Pension Accounting Office (CPAO) New Delhi and paid by SBI.

- (c) Suggestion received from one of the Pensioner for uploading of Important Notices/Orders pertaining to Pensioners.

It was apprised by the Member Secretary to the Adalat that all such Notices/Orders are available in public domain.

- (d) Suggestion received for having more pensioners' representatives in the Pension Adalat

Adalat deliberated that since the numbers of SCL pensioners are 82 only and that at present not many grievances/suggestions are received, the matter may be considered at a later date.

4. Chairman thanked all the members and invitees present for making it convenient to attend the Pension Adalat.
